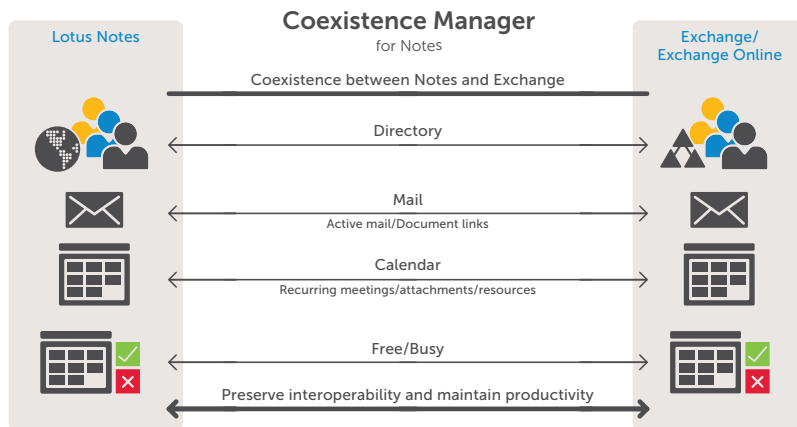


Figure 1. Coexistence Manager for Notes enables Notes and Exchange users to collaborate, view free/busy information, schedule meetings and more.

Lotus Domino version 6.5.1–6.5.6, 7.0.0–7.0.4, 8.0.0–8.0.2 or 8.5.0–8.5.3 Hardware

### Exchange server(s)

Exchange 2013, 2010 (SP0, SP1, SP2 or SP3), 2007 (SP0, SP1, SP2 or SP3) or 2003

### Notes end-user workstations

Notes client version 6.5.1–6.5.6, 7.0.0–7.0.4, 8.0.0–8.0.2, or 8.5.0–8.5.3

Outlook client version 2003, 2007, 2010 or 2013, or Outlook Web Access 2007 or 2010

Coexistence Manager for Notes ensures the accuracy of email and calendar data, including recurring meetings and active mail, mitigating the risk of lost or delayed operations. It also preserves user collaboration by synchronizing directories and enabling free/busy queries between platforms.

### Features

**Active mail processing**—Dell's patent-pending technology provides Exchange users with access to advanced formatting and live Notes content from within their Outlook client. This functionality includes encryption, embedded buttons, hotspots, collapsible sections and tabbed tables. Without Coexistence Manager for Notes, active mail features are not viewable or actionable in Outlook, prohibiting true coexistence.

**No need for Domino databases**—Coexistence Manager for Notes processes active mail without storing content on Domino databases, eliminating setup, access control and maintenance of additional Domino databases during the coexistence period.

**Scalability**—You can deploy multiple instances of Coexistence Manager for Notes to increase scalability, as well as improve load balancing and failover.

**Directory synchronization**—Coexistence Manager for Notes synchronizes directories between Notes and Exchange 2003/2007/2010/2013, enabling users to view a common list of users, groups and resources, no matter

where their mailbox resides. Microsoft offers this functionality for Exchange 2007 but no longer provides it for Exchange 2010 or 2013.

**Free/busy connection**—Coexistence Manager for Notes provides free/busy queries between Notes and Exchange 2003/2007/2010/2013, Office 365 and hosted Exchange, enabling users to schedule meetings and view co-workers' availability, no matter where their mailboxes reside. Although this functionality is offered by Microsoft for migrations to Exchange 2007, Microsoft no longer provides it for Exchange 2010 or 2013.

**Calendar sharing**—Coexistence Manager for Notes ensures that custom and recurring calendar invitations process accurately when sent between platforms. This enables Notes and Exchange users to collaborate and schedule meetings no matter where their mailbox resides.

**Link tracking**—The link tracking service ensures that embedded email links to Notes documents continue to be routed correctly throughout the coexistence period, preserving business productivity.
